common set of measures for IPE experiences, we will begin to develop a large set of common data points allowing more ready comparison of IPE experiences and outcomes

for students in diverse educational settings across the Commonwealth of Virginia. If this model of virtual collaboration utilizing telepresence is successful for planning,

implementing, and evaluating IPE efforts replication at the national level could move the science of IPE forward at a much more rapid pace than ever before.
